BASIC CHILD SAFETY RULES

1. Respect for Every Child

- Every child must be treated with kindness, dignity, and respect.
 - Bullying, harassment, discrimination, or abusive language is strictly prohibited.

2. Supervision

- All activities must be supervised by responsible club leaders, coaches, or authorized adults.
 - No child shall be left unattended during official club activities.

3. Safe Environment

- The club shall provide a safe and friendly environment for all members.
 - Dangerous behaviour, fighting, or violence is not allowed.

4. Attendance and Permission

- Children must attend activities with parent/guardian permission.
 - No child shall leave an activity venue without informing a club leader or parent/guardian.

5. Emergency Preparedness

- Emergency contact information for every child must be available during activities.

- Injuries, illness, or accidents must be reported immediately to club management and parents/guardians.

6. Health and Medical Care

- Parents/guardians must disclose any medical condition, allergy, or special need of the child.
 - Children who are unwell may be advised not to participate in certain activities.

7. Transport Safety

- Children must follow safety instructions during transportation and trips.
 - Organized transport arrangements shall prioritize the safety of all members.

8. Appropriate Conduct

- Members must follow instructions from club leaders and coaches at all times.
 - Use of drugs, alcohol, smoking, or dangerous substances is strictly prohibited.

9. Protection of Personal Property

- Members should take care of their belongings.
 - The club is not responsible for loss of personal items brought without approval.

10. Photography and Media

- Photos or videos of children during activities may only be taken for official club purposes with parent/guardian awareness.

11. Reporting Concerns

- Any safety concern, misconduct, or inappropriate behaviour must be reported immediately to club management or parents/guardians.
